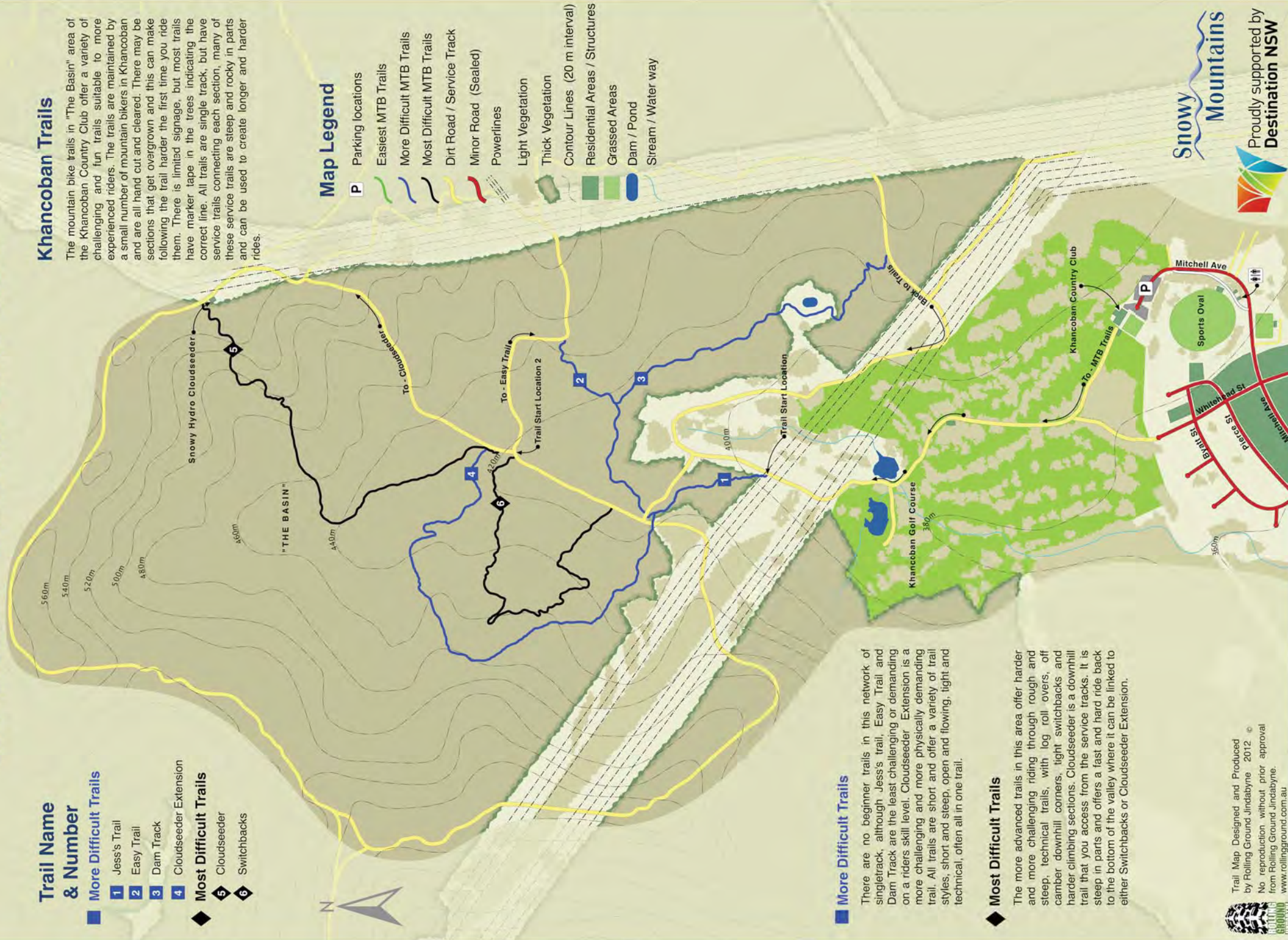
Khancoban Trails

The mountain bike trails in "The Basin" area of the Khancoban Country Club offer a variety of challenging and fun trails suitable to more experienced riders. The trails are maintained by a small number of mountain bikers in Khancoban and are all hand cut and cleared. There may be sections that get overgrown and this can make following the trail harder the first time you ride them. There is limited signage, but most trails have marker tape in the trees indicating the correct line. All trails are single track, but have service trails connecting each section, many of these service trails are steep and rocky in parts and can be used to create longer and harder rides.

More Difficult Trails

There are no beginner trails in this network of singletrack, although Jess's trail, Easy Trail and Dam Track are the least challenging or demanding on a riders skill level. Cloudseeder Extension is a more challenging and more physically demanding trail. All trails are short and offer a variety of trail styles, short and steep, open and flowing, tight and technical, often all in one trail.

Most Difficult Trails

The more advanced trails in this area offer harder and more challenging riding through rough and steep, technical trails, with log roll overs, off camber downhill corners, tight switchbacks and harder climbing sections. Cloudseeder is a downhill trail that you access from the service tracks. It is steep in parts and offers a fast and hard ride back to the bottom of the valley where it can be linked to either Switchbacks or Cloudseeder Extension.
